Enclosed is **the schedule for Jan 2012 through April 15, 2012**. We have served the Chalice for a full year and it seems to be going smoothly. During Ash Wednesday and Easter Masses we will serve The Host only (except at the Easter Vigil).

You may have seen the Sanitizer on the SJ Rail side of the Sanctuary for use by those Eucharistic Ministers serving the Host. As you approach the bottom step of the Sanctuary please use while standing and waiting for the priest to consume (before approaching the Altar).

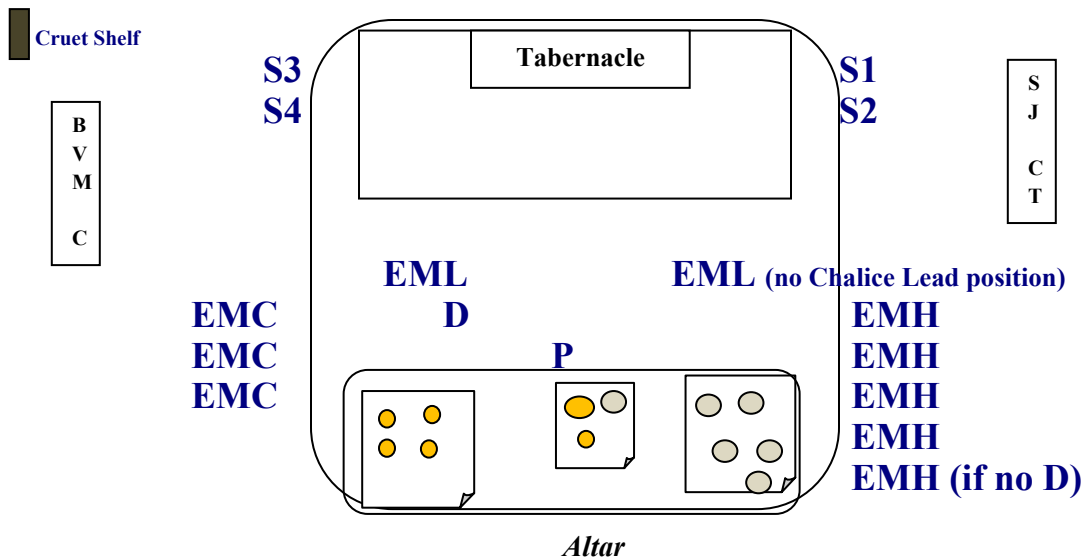
**Designated Easter Masses will have 8 serving position/stations. The eight Cards will be on

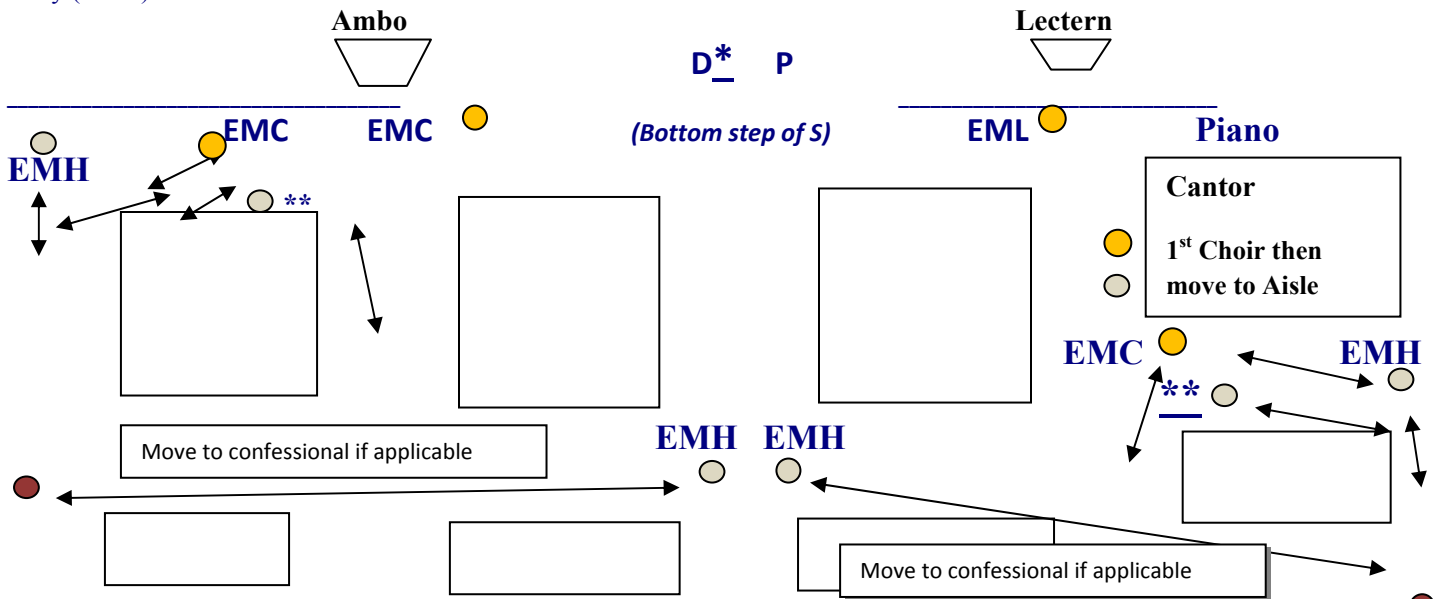
Positions After Celebrant receives Holy Communion
